All the interested parties are informed that Indian Institute of Integrative Medicine (IIIM), Branch Srinagar is going to hold an Open Public Auction of Walnut fruit for the year 2018 of the Field Stations located at Yarikha, Tangmarg and Bonera, Pulwama as:

**2) Date & Time of Open Public Auction at F/S Yarikha: 30<sup>th</sup> August 2018 at 11:00 AM**

**Interested bidders may inspect the fruits of walnut trees to be auctioned at the Field Stations on any working day from 13<sup>th</sup> August to 28<sup>th</sup> August 2018 between 10.00 A.M. to 5.00 P.M.**

**General Terms & Conditions of Public Auction of Walnut fruit at F/S Bonera and Yarikha:**

1. The walnut fruit is auctioned only on "AS IS WHEREAS BASIS". Only the fruits are being auctioned.
2. Each bidder has to register himself on the spot before the start of public auction at each farm and deposit an amount of Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) as earnest money in the form of Cash or Demand Draft in favour of Director, IIIM, Canal Road Jammu.
3. 25% of the successful bid amount is to be paid by the successful highest bidder on the spot and the balance 75% amount within 05 days after acceptance and award of tender by the Competent Authority. The balance 75% has to be deposited in IIIM Bank account by the successful bidder. The EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be refunded immediately on the spot after the process of public auction is completed. If the successful bidder fails to submit the balance requisite amount then he/she forfeits the bid amount already deposited. Taxes & duties, if any, leviable by the Govt., at the time of final payment, will be extra as applicable.
4. 25% of the bid amount of the successful bidder will be adjusted against the final payment to be made by him after award of the tender.

5. The successful bidder shall have to pay the tax, if any, as admissible under rules, which should be over and above the bid amount offered by the successful bidder.
6. Watch and Ward arrangement should be made by the successful bidder immediately after the award of bid and IIM would not be responsible for theft and damage by natural calamities, climatic hazard etc, thereafter.
7. The responsibility of harvesting of walnuts rests with the bidder and it has to be carried out by him/her through his/her own labourers at his/her own risk and responsibility in the presence of our farm staff. The bidder will be allowed to carry out his activities during the normal working hours of the farm (9.00 A.M. to 5.30 P.M.). No child labour shall be employed for any of the works involved.
8. Any loss, damage or pilferage of property of IIM including trees, plantation and other crops caused by the bidder or his workers during harvesting of walnuts shall be personal responsibility of the bidder/contractor, which will be recovered outright.
9. In case of any dispute in these transactions, the same shall be restricted to the Jurisdiction of courts at Jammu only.
10. The Director, IIM reserves its absolute right to accept or reject any or all bids without assigning any reason thereof.
