ABOUT VENUE

The Institute was established in 1941 as a research lab. and production centre, known as Drug Research Laboratory of J&K State and was later taken over by Council of Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR) of Govt. of India in December 1957 as Regional Research Laboratory, Jammu. In view of its core strength in natural products-based drug discovery, the mandate of Institute was redefined in 2007 and its name changed to the Indian Institute of Integrative Medicine (IIIM). The current mandate of IIIM is to discover new drugs and therapeutic approaches from Natural Products, both of plant and microbial origin, enabled by biotechnology, to develop technologies, drugs and products of high value for the national and international markets.

Indian Institute of Integrative Medicine (IIIM) Branch, Srinagar is a state of the art laboratory located in the suburbs of the picturesque Srinagar city. From the very inception this branch of IIIM has contributed immensely towards the social betterment/upliftment by fostering HRD as well as setting up small scale industries. Currently the focus of the institute is to exploit the unique bio-diversity of Kashmir valley with special emphasis on medicinal and aromatic plants and microbes for drug development. The branch Lab at Srinagar is supported by three experimental farm fields located at different agro-climatic zones in Kashmir namely Bonera in Pulwama, yarikah in Baramulla & Verinag in Anantnag Districts.

The workshop shall be held at IIIM (Br) Srinagar situated at Sanatnagar locality of District Srinagar. Srinagar is the summer capital of Jammu and Kashmir (UT). It is situated in the centre of the Kashmir Valley on the banks of the Jhelum River and is surrounded by four districts and Ladakh UT. The city is located on both the sides of the Jhelum River, which is called Vyath in Kashmir. The river passes through the city and meanders through the valley, moving onward and deepening in the Dal Lake. Dal Lake is a major landmark and a top tourist attraction which is in the heart of the city. It is quite popular for its house-boats. Srinagar also has many beautiful gardens and religious shrines. The average temp. in the month of October shall be around 220 in day and 100 in night.
