- 1. The position is purely temporary and co-terminus with the project. The engagement shall be initially for a period of one year or till the project duration, whichever is earlier. The engagement shall be extendable on yearly basis subject to performance review and project duration. The duration of the projectis up to 31.03.2025.
- 2. The engagement of a project staff in different projects either in the CSIR Indian Institute of Integrative Medicine, Jammu or different Lab./Instt. of CSIR taken together shall not exceed 5 years in any case.
